Being the only national youth orchestra in France, the OFJ brings together about 120 musicians each year, from 16 to 25 and from 75 departments including outseas ones. Through each intensive musical sessions in la Saline royale d'Arc-et-Senans and the Opera of Dijon, they experiment a human and artistical adventure, off the beaten tracks, based on passion, high standards and transmission.. as well as a committed vision of culture.

An orchestra for each and everyone

30 to 40% of our musicians get scholarships. Throughout this equal opportunity scheme/program, the OFJ makes sure that every social origins is represented, and helps convincing young musicians from modest backgrounds of their legitimacy inside this orchestra.

A concrete, sustainable and civic commitment

OFJ aims to train citizen-musicians:

- initiatives in schools, carceral structures and retirement home
- participatory projects and regional residencies
- ambitious educational partnerships (Demos, Jeux Olympiades)
- a pioneering commitment to eco-responsability (green charter, mass transportation modes, local initiative, awareness-raising workshops)

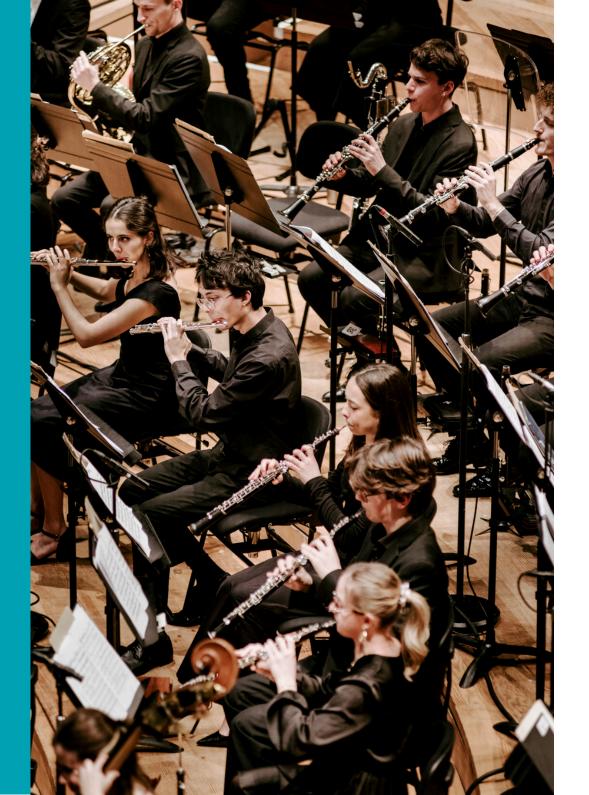

Fiscal benefits for your donation

In France, sponsorship beneficiates from a favourable taxation framework. Every physical person can deduce 60% from the amount of his donation for his income taxes, within the limits of 20% from his taxable income. This scheme, listed in article 200 from the Taxation General Code, represents a real leverage to support a meaningful cultural project.

In concrete terms, a **10 000 euros donation** will cost you, after fiscal deducation, only **3 400 euros**. This tax relief makes it easy to engage a long-term commitment to financing the cultural sector.
